Town of Winn Freedom of Access Request Form 2024/2025

In the State of Maine, every City/Town is required to respond individually to FOAA requests for its own records. Requests may be made verbally, via email, written via request form, or by visiting the Town Office during business hours.

The Freedom of Access Act does not require that FOAA requests be in writing. However, the Town of Winn kindly requests individuals to submit requests in writing to maintain a record of when the request was received and what records were specifically requested. If email communication is preferred, complete this form, and attach. EMAILS: Putting FOAA Request in the subject line when sending, may speed up the received date stamp and the processing of requests.

What are the costs? As of October 18, 2021, a City/Town may charge \$25 per hour after the first two (2) hours of staff time per request. 1 M.R.S. § 408-A(8)(B) When conversion of a record is necessary to release, the City / Town may also charge a fee to cover the actual cost of conversion. 1 M.R.S. § 408-A(8)(C)
